

MASTER'S DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

The degree of Master of Arts (MA) or Master of Science (MS) will be granted to the student who has registered for a master's degree on a "MA/MS Degree Programme Planning Form" which has been fully approved and who has satisfied the following requirements:

- Discipleship Training School Prerequisite (19-24 credits) - both ___ lecture phase (11 week minimum and ___ field assignment (8 week minimum) are required.
- Cross-Cultural Requirement.
- Core Curriculum Requirement: Bible. For those students with no previous university-level Bible courses, one of the following courses in Bible is required: CHR 211, 213, 225, 227, 221/322/323.
- Residency Requirement (two courses) from what location: _____.
- Bachelor's Degree or Equivalent Requirement
- Language Proficiency in: _____.
- YWAM/U of N Field Assignment/Internship Credits: 12 credits.
- No pass/fail courses.
- General Transfer Credit Policy and Procedure (number of credits is at the discretion of the Provost).
- A Thesis is an option for the master's degree. (no more than 6 credits). A thesis is optional for all MA/MS candidates. Maximum 6 credits are granted for the MA/MS thesis. The work must be done under the direction of a faculty advisor in the appropriate College/Faculty, and must be applicable to the curriculum of the degree programme. During this time the student must be in regular contact with the thesis advisor who evaluates the thesis work. The U of N guidelines for preparation and defense of a thesis are found in the *U of N Reference Guide* and are available through the College/Faculty Advisors and International Deans. A master's degree student is expected to orally defend their thesis as described in the document on thesis guidelines in the U of N Reference Guide.
- Satisfactory completion of all required courses for degree programme, including pre-approved electives. A grade-point average of at least "B" is required to successfully complete a U of N master's degree.
- Total credits fulfilled: at least 48 for a MA/MS (beyond the completion of the DTS lecture and field assignment/outreach).
- Satisfactory clearance of financial accounts of U of N schools and seminars.
- A "U of N Application for Graduation Form" is to be submitted six months before the conclusion of the degree program; otherwise, we cannot guarantee timely completion of the transcript or the diploma.
